

Flash cards

There are many different uses for flash cards. This list is in no way exhaustive, and we encourage teachers to be creative.

The teacher or translator can hold up word cards and pupils can identify them by putting up their hand and identifying the word in English.

The teacher or translator can hold up picture cards and pupils can identify them by putting up their hand and saying the French word.

A more interesting way of doing this is to share out the picture cards to the class or group. The teacher or translator then holds up a word card (or writes the word on the board) and those who can identify the French word from their cards holds up their matching picture card.

Alternatively the teacher or translator shares out the word cards and holds up the picture cards for the pupils to match to their word cards.

This way of using Français Snap can be done in small peer led groups or in full class using multiple card packs.
